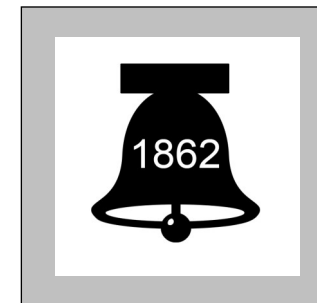

- Provide an acceptable, regular amount of homework appropriate to the age, ability and needs of pupils;
- Maintain a fair, consistently applied positive Behaviour Policy which adequately prepares children to be responsible, active participants in society;
- Inform parents / carers at an early stage of any concerns we may have regarding their child, to enable a successful partnership between home and school in meeting the learning needs of the child and resolving difficulties;
- Provide details about the curriculum being taught through termly 'topic web' information, and also through occasional Open Days, workshop sessions or presentations for parents / carers;
- Provide information regarding each child's progress and areas for development through Parents' Evenings and an annual end-of-year report.

The Family will:

- Ensure that their child attends school regularly, arriving on time and properly prepared / equipped;
- Send a note to the child's teacher or telephone/email the office to explain any absence from school;
- Support the school's general policies and rules;
- Make every effort to attend Parents' Evenings to discuss their child's progress;
- Inform the school of any problems which may affect work or behaviour;
- Encourage their child to care for others and their belongings, showing respect to other pupils, staff and property;
- Make every effort to share in their child's life at school, supporting them with interests, homework and other opportunities for home learning;
