### **Year 3 & 4 - Cirencester Corinium Museum trip - 20<sup>th</sup> October 2025**

We are excited to share that Owls Class will be joined by Oak Hill's Elm Class on a visit to the Corinium Museum in Cirencester on Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> October. This is a fantastic opportunity to explore galleries that offer an exceptional interactive experience.

The trip will support our learning in the first two history units of the year: *Would you prefer to live in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age?* (Autumn 2) and *Why did the Romans settle in Britain?* (Spring 2). It will also link to our Latin studies, which often explore not only the Roman language but also Roman culture.

During the visit, children will have the chance to see prehistoric tools, Roman mosaics, Anglo-Saxon grave goods, medieval sculptures, and more. Please find below a link to the Corinium Museum's website below:
