Dear Parents and Carers,

We will soon be attending Young Voices on **16<sup>th</sup> January 2026 at Resorts World Arena, Birmingham**. This letter is to inform you of the plans for the day and important information. Please read it carefully as there is quite a lot of information!

Today I will be sending out transfer emails with your tickets, they may have gone into your junk/spam folder. To get these you will need the AXS app on your phone, then you use a QR code to enter the arena on the night. Please accept these tickets asap just in case there are any issues.

On the day of the event, children need to come into school at the usual time, with their normal school uniform. They must wear a **plain white t-shirt or Young Voices t-shirt** under their school jumper/cardigan. **This is essential as the event organisers like all the children to look the same for their performance.** If your child got a free light with their t-shirt then please bring that along too!

We will be using a coach service for our transport to and from the venue which we will be sharing with Oakhill. Children must use this and cannot return home with parents as it will be too busy at the venue to accommodate this. We imagine the coach will return to school around 11pm, but will keep in contact via message on the evening to give you a more accurate time. Children will need to be collected promptly from school.

The children will leave school during the morning and travel to Birmingham for lunchtime. We will have lunch, then attend rehearsals in the afternoon. We will then have tea before the performance where hopefully we will see some of you! Once I know roughly where we are in the arena I will ensure you all know so you can look out for us. I should have this information next week.

Due to being out of school for lunch and tea children will need **two meals**. Please send these in a backpack and ensure children know which food is for which meal so they don't eat it all at lunchtime. Children will also need a full water bottle. These must all be named please. They are also welcome to bring a book or small card game to play on the coach/during mealtimes.

Between now and the event please encourage your child to continue to practise the songs and dances which are all available via the Young Voices Music Room. There is one new song that has been added, called Original (Under Guest Artist Song), this has been added since our last club session unfortunately so I have been unable to practise it with the children.
