PE

- **PE will continue on Monday afternoons with Mr Sallis.** Children should come to school dressed in their PE kit, which they will wear for the whole day. As the weather (hopefully) gets warmer, please ensure they have a hat and sun cream.
- **Swimming will begin on Tuesday 21st April** and will run for six weeks. We will be leaving school at 8:50am so please ensure your child arrives promptly (and goes straight to the hall for registration).
