Re: Trip to the Houses of Parliament

We are delighted to announce that our Year 6 cohort, along with Oak Hill's Year 6s, have been selected to visit the UK Parliament for **Learn with the Lords Day** on **Tuesday 5th May**! This fantastic experience will form an amazing extension to our learning, allowing children the chance to see first-hand how democracy works in the UK. We will:

- Arrive at the Education Centre entrance in Victoria Tower Gardens.
- Be guided through airport style security checks and deposit belongings.
- Enjoy a guided tour of the Palace of Westminster, including time to watch the House of Lords and House of Commons Chambers in action.
- Visit the Education Centre for a 30-minute workshop, focussed on the role of the House of Lords in making laws.
- Have 30-minutes Q&A, with the chance to put questions to a member of the House of Lords.
- Have lunch for 30-minutes, before boarding the coach back.
