Re: Trip to Eastnor Castle

We are excited to announce our next **Primary QuEST event** will be held at **Eastnor Castle on Tuesday 2nd June 2026**. Pupils in year 3 from the Primary QuEST schools will meet up for an outdoor adventure day.

Eastnor Castle is near Ledbury and has hosted this event for Primary QuEST over the past three years. The castle will be closed to the public during our visit. We are asking for a voluntary contribution for the trip of £20 towards the entrance fee and transport costs, via ParentPay please, where you will automatically give your consent for your child to attend the trip. During the visit, the pupils will be able to explore the castle and grounds and they will complete a number of activities with the pupils from across the trust.

The children will travel to and from the castle by coach and will need to bring a packed lunch and drink with them. Dependent on the weather forecast, a waterproof coat is advisable. The coach will be leaving Gretton at 8:50am, so please make sure your child is in school on time. Our return time is estimated to coincide with the end of the school day, but we will stay in contact by text if we are running late.

The date of this trip means that unfortunately Y3 will miss the final swimming session, so their swimming assessments will take place the previous week.
