We are looking for people who can think strategically, ask thoughtful questions, work collaboratively and share a commitment to improving outcomes for young people. Local Advisors come from a wide range of backgrounds and do not need previous experience in education. Training and support are provided.

We are looking for people who can bring life experience, professional skills, good judgement and a willingness to ask questions and support the school.

Please don't just think about whether this role is right for you. Think about whether you know someone who could make a difference.

Do you have a friend, family member, colleague, employer, business contact or member of a local organisation who might be interested in supporting the school community? A personal recommendation is often the best way for someone to discover governance.

The role is voluntary, training and support are provided, and it offers a rewarding opportunity to contribute to the success of young people while developing strategic leadership skills.
