Outcomes: Dialogue, diary entry, re-telling (oral dictation), mini-autobiography, ship's log

Main outcome: Non-chronological report

The Selfish Giant

Outcomes: Letters, setting description, first person recount, diaries, letters, adverts, reports

Main outcome: Own version narrative about kindness

Outcomes: Diary entry, instructions, letter, description, speech

Main outcome: Explanation of a life cycle
